Craft Along with Me – Supply List

We're making a fun alternative card together during Friday's Instagram Live using the **August Paper Pumpkin: Farmhouse Florals**. Don't worry if you don't have the exact kit or papers — grab something similar! The idea is to follow the **same layout and design** while putting your own creative spin on it.

Your card doesn't have to look identical to mine. In fact, I'd love to see everyone's different versions shared after the live.

Card Base & Layers

- ☐ 4-1/4" x 11" cardstock, scored at 5-1/2" (I used Basic Beige)
- ☐ 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" coordinating cardstock (pick a color that matches your DSP)
- ☐ 2" x 2" scrap of coordinating cardstock (I used Poppy Parade)
- ☐ 3-3/4" x 5" neutral DSP (I used *Country Woods*)
- ☐ 3-3/4" x 1-1/2" patterned DSP (I used *Everyday Happiness*)

Focal Elements

- ☐ 1 die-cut circle (I used *Circle of Seasons Dies*)
- ☐ 1 typewriter card base (from the August Paper Pumpkin kit – or swap with any focal image from another kit!)
- ☐ *Just a Note Bundle*
 - ☐ Line images (stamps)
 - ☐ Paper clip dies
 - ☐ Little note sheet die

Tools & Inks

- ☐ Basic stamping tools (acrylic blocks, snips, bone folder, etc.)
- ☐ Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
- ☐ Paper trimmer
- ☐ Adhesive (tape runner, liquid glue, or your favorite)
- ☐ 1-3/4" circle punch (or a die if you prefer)
- ☐ Circle of Seasons Dies (optional, but nice to have)
- ☐ Early Espresso & Crumb Cake ink pads (any neutral brown inks will work)
- ☐ Poppy Parade Stampin' Blend or Marker (or a coordinating marker of your choice)
- ☐ Ruler or straight edge (for **drawing a line**)

Finishing Touches

- ☐ Linen thread
- ☐ Coordinating ribbon (about 15")
